

European Association of Dental Public Health Travel Grant Guidelines

EADPH members submitting an abstract on any topic relevant to dental public health for presentation at the annual EADPH congress may apply for a travel grant. PLEASE NOTE THAT TRAVEL GRANTS ARE ONLY AVAILABLE TO EADPH MEMBERS. THEREFORE WE INVITE YOU TO JOIN EADPH BEFORE YOU SUBMIT YOUR ABSTRACT (see the membership section on website)

Delegates are only permitted to present one abstract. You may, however, be a co-author of other abstracts. Abstracts must be submitted electronically via the abstract submission form on the EADPH website www.eadph.org Remember to click the box for a travel grant when submitting your abstract.

Note that delegates who wish to apply for a travel grant award must submit their abstracts by the closing date (**15 March 2015**).

Up to 10 travel awards of €500 each have been awarded by The Borrow Foundation and 5 travel awards of €500 each have been awarded by Colgate.

Conditions for the travel grant;

- EADPH members must submit their abstract before the **15th March 2015**.
- The award of a travel grant carries with it the obligation for members to register and present at the conference.
- The conference registration fee and any other conference costs incurred by EADPH will be deducted from the €500 travel grant of successful applicants.
- The balance of the travel grant will be paid at the annual congress.
- Priority will be given to researchers whose first degree was obtained in the last 10 years.
- Priority will be given to applicants from countries with a Gross National Income per capita of US\$15,000 or less (World Bank GNI).
- Priority will be given to EADPH members who have not received a grant in the last 3 years.
- Abstracts received after the early closing date (**15th March 2015**) will not be eligible for a grant.
- Applicants living in the country hosting the annual congress are not eligible to apply for a travel grant.

The decision of the Abstract Reviewing Committee is final in deciding who will receive travel grants.
